What is Timbertop?

Timbertop Camp is a residential camp designed for boys and girls, ages 8-13, who have been identified by their school districts as needing extra help for a learning disability.

Timbertop combines traditional camp activities with extra reading practice and special group activities that focus on dealing with learning disabilities in a structured daily setting. Emphasis is placed on peer relations, building self-confidence, learning new skills to share at home and of course, having fun; all in a non-competitive outdoor setting.

Enrollment is limited to 40 campers.



Our History

Timbertop Camp celebrates its 50th anniversary this summer. It is jointly sponsored by the YMCA and the Association for Services for Learning Disabilities, a non-profit corporation founded in 1967 which sponsors camping for children with learning disabilities.

Our Facilities

Camp is held at YMCA Camp Glacier Hollow, 14 miles east of Stevens Point. Campers stay in cabins and enjoy a log style dining lodge with a recreation center, screened campfire gazebo, health lodge, trading post and bathrooms with hot showers and flush toilets.

The camp is located on beautiful spring fed Lake Elaine and offers a diverse landscape, making it an ideal setting for operating our YMCA Camp.

Camp Details

Timbertop is a 7 day outdoor adventure where campers will learn outdoor skills and participate in activities designed to enhance their cooperative abilities and interpersonal relationships. An emphasis is placed on building self-esteem and how to make and keep friends. Whether building a campfire, cleaning the cabin or learning how to handle a canoe, each camper learns to share the responsibility of camp life. The daily schedule includes: reading instruction, swim lessons, cabin activities, camp classes (such as nature exploration, canoeing, arts & crafts, archery, fishing, games and more), evening campfires, stargazing and all-camp programs.

Camp Dates

August 6-12, 2017

Arrive between 2:00 and 3:30 pm on Sunday and depart at 12:30 pm on Saturday. An awards ceremony is held at 11:30 am on Saturday.

Contact the YMCA for application materials. A \$100 non-refundable deposit is due with your application to secure a spot. Balance is due (4) four weeks prior to camp.

You will be notified of your child's acceptance after we review your application and school information. Eligibility is based on Camp being able to meet the needs of each child.

Camp Staff & Leadership

Our staff are selected for their leadership skills and their ability to provide a meaningful and safe camp experience for youth. Staff have an understanding of youth with special needs and the unique potential of each child. **There is a ratio of one adult to every five campers.**

Pete Matthai "Timber" is the Camp Director for the Stevens Point Area YMCA and has been working with Timbertop since 1991. The camp Founder and Co-Director, Rhoda Brooks "Wings", holds an M.A. in Special Education and has over 30 years of teaching and administrative experience. Nancy Reuter "Spirit" has worked with Timbertop since 1992 and is also a special education teacher in Mosinee, WI.
