(*All Stevens Point Area YMCA Family and Single Parent Family members are eligible for a \$25 member discount per resident camp, excluding LIT Camps)

LEADER AND COUNSELOR IN TRAINING PROGRAM - AGES 12-17

Teens who successfully complete the LIT Day or CIT Training Camp are eligible to become "LITs" (Leaders In Training, ages 12-14) or "CITs" (Counselors In Training, ages 15-17). Successful LIT's/CIT's will be able to come back for a future week to assist our full-time camp staff!

LEADER IN TRAINING "LIT" (AGES 12-14, MUST BE ENTERING 7TH GRADE)

The LIT Program is for youth that want to have a fun summer developing their leadership skills, creating self-confidence, and making new friendships. LITs use their skills to help support Y staff and interact with children in our Day Camp while continuing their training throughout the summer.

- LIT's must first successfully complete the LIT Training Camp at Glacier Hollow from June 21-25.
- An application and registration form are required before being accepted into LIT Training Camp.
- LIT's depart from the Y at 8:30AM and return at 4:30PM. An overnight at Camp (Thurs.-Fri.) is required, in which participants depart from the Y on Thursday morning and can be picked up Friday at camp following the 2:15PM Graduation Ceremony or return to the Y on the bus at 4:30PM.
- Daily lunch, snacks, and overnight meals are provided.

Participants that successfully complete Training Camp will be placed as LIT's in Day Camp programs throughout the summer, for one of the following weeks: July 12-16, July 26-30, or August 16-20. The Leader In Training Program requires a commitment of at least 1 week, in addition to Training Camp. Depending on enrollment numbers, LIT's may be eligible to participate in an additional week. LITs are held to high standards and can be removed from the program if not meeting those standards.

COUNSELOR IN TRAINING "CIT" (Ages 15-17)

The Counselor In Training program steps up from our LIT Program, allowing our more experienced Campers opportunities to continue developing their leadership skills, while working with children alongside our YMCA staff, all while having fun at Camp!

- CIT's must first successfully complete the CIT Training Camp at Glacier Hollow from June 21-25.
- An application and registration form are required before being accepted into CIT Training Camp.
- Participants that successfully pass CIT Training Camp will be placed as CIT's in Day or Resident Camp programs throughout the summer, for one of the following weeks: June 27-July 2 OR July 18-23. The CIT Program requires a commitment of at least 1 week in addition to Training Camp. Depending on enrollment numbers, CIT's may be eligible to participate in an additional week. CITs are held to high standards and can be removed from the program if not meeting those standards.
